

PPS 2003 EUROPE/AFRICA REGIONAL MEETING SEPTEMBER 14-17, 2003 ATHENS, GREECE

The Europe/Africa Regional Meeting of the Polymer Processing Society (PPS-2003) took place in Athens, Greece. The meeting started with registration on Sunday afternoon, 14 September 2003 and ended on Wednesday afternoon, 17 September 2003, at the Hotel Armonia, in beautiful Vouliagmeni bay. The Conference was attended by 214 delegates from 32 countries, thus making it a truly international event. It included 2 plenary and 36 keynote lectures. The scientific papers were presented under 15 major themes. A total number of 264 papers were divided into two categories: 177 oral and 87 posters.
