■ Five Groups Set in the Chinese Society of Rheology

Considering that Rheology covers quite a wide range of subjects and industries, for the convenience of convening academic activities, five groups are set up in the Chinese Society of Rheology as follows: Polymer Rheology; Solid Rheology and Constitutive Theory; Electro-Magneto Rheology; Petroleum, Rock and Soil Rheology; and Engineering Applied Rheology. Each member is expected to focus on one group according to his/her own research interest while participation in other groups is encouraged.

■ The Ninth National Conference on Rheology

The Ninth National Conference on Rheology will be held in Changsha, the capital of Hunan province, from September 28 to October 1, 2008. Sponsored by National Natural Science Foundation of China and Natural Science Foundation of Hunan Province, this conference is hosted by the Central South University of Forestry and Technology in collaboration with Hunan University of Technology, Xiangtan University and the Hunan Society of Theoretical and Applied Mechanics. Panel and academic sessions will address a broad range of topics including Constitutive Theory & Modeling, Polymer Solution and Melts, Electro-magneto Rheology and Applications of Rheology in various industrial sectors, etc. Rheological apparatus and publications will be exhibited during the conference. What's more, the fifth Chinese Young Rheologists Award and the first Chinese Outstanding Contribution Award to Rheology will be announced at the conference. Official languages of the conference are Chinese and English. Besides the academic program, an active social program is planned which will introduce the participants to the wonderful attractions of Zhangjiajie National Forest Park. 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■ The Fifth National Conference on Electrorheological Fluid and Magnetorheological Suspensions

The Fifth National Conference on Electrorheological Fluid and Magnetorheological Suspensions (EFAMS) will be held in Dalian University of Technology, Liaoning, and P.R.China from October 23 to 25, 2008. This conference, hosted by Dalian University of Technology in collaboration with Harbin Institute of Technology, focuses on the technology and application of electrorheological fluid and magnetorheological suspensions. Panel and academic sessions will address a broad range of topics and issues including Mechanism and Application of EFAMS, Manufacturing & Production of EFAMS, Apparatus & Technology of EFAMS Application, etc.

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
